

Read 11 great books, study with your team, participate in fun inperson and virtual activities January & February!




Culminating with a 50 question LIVE competition and Victory Party in March at LO HS Auditorium!



Party celebrating over 3 months of hard work! All teams will be recognized, top three teams and team awards given out! Also hear from a Battle author.



Where can I register? Online on the library's <u>website!</u>


Do I need a team ready to register? No, registration is individual.
